

Operations Management Concentration (18 units)

The curriculum in Operations Management (OM) is concerned with the organization, methods, and language employed in managing production/operations systems which turn out goods or services. Students who concentrate in OM are provided with a well-balanced program of qualitative and quantitative subject matter as well as an appreciation of the human element in organizations; therefore, they should be able to assume first-level line or staff positions in production/operations systems for either manufacturing, service, or government organizations. (*Prerequisite courses are noted in parentheses.*)
